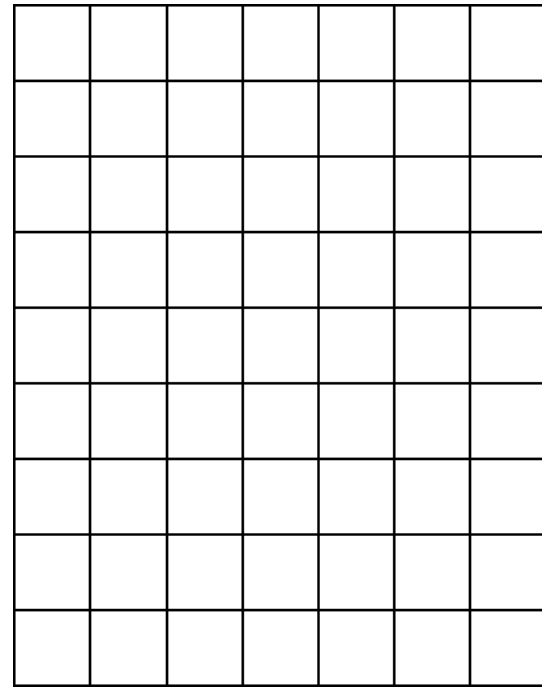
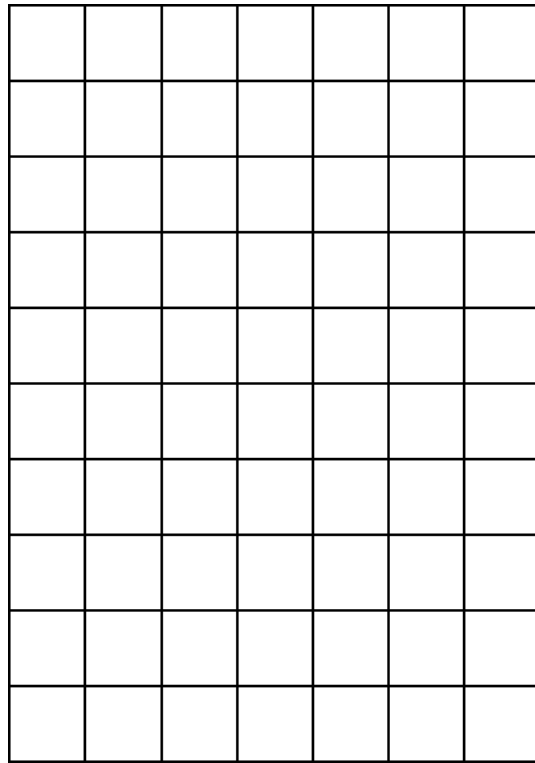
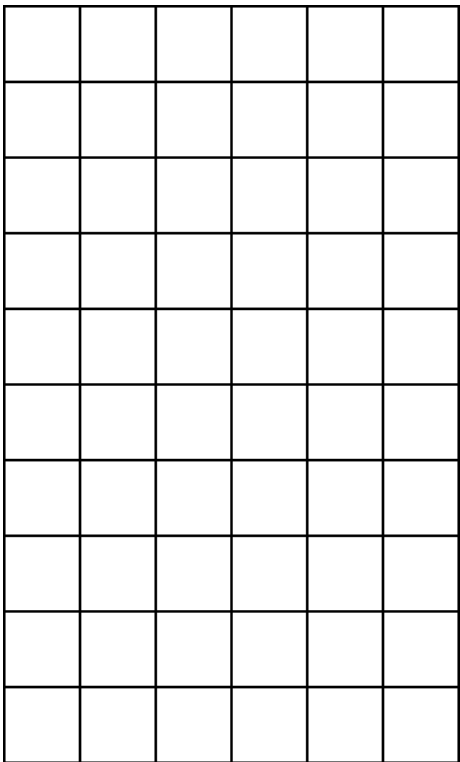
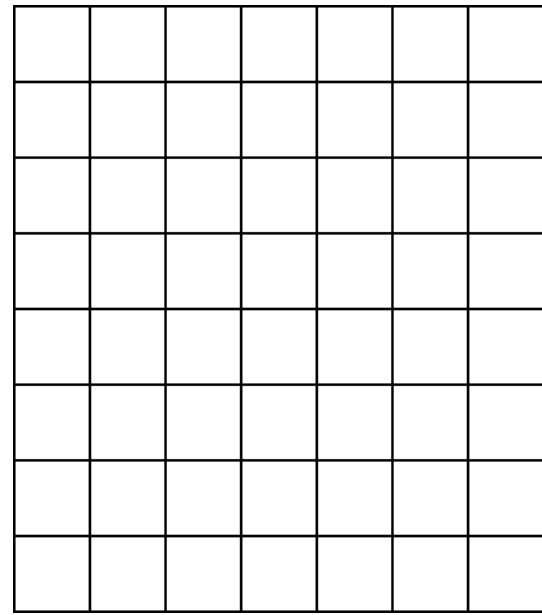
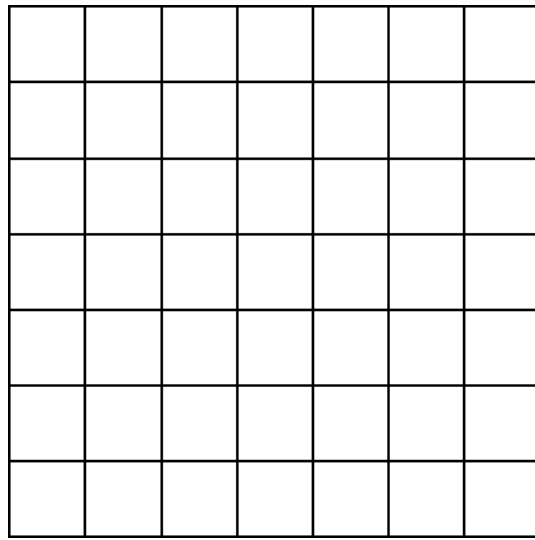
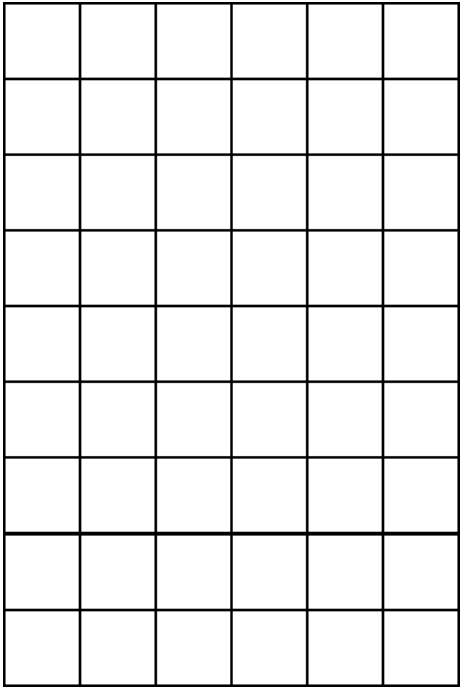
- Array cards (with the multiplication expression on the array side ex. 2×3 , 3×2 ; an the product on the blank, reverse side ex. 6)

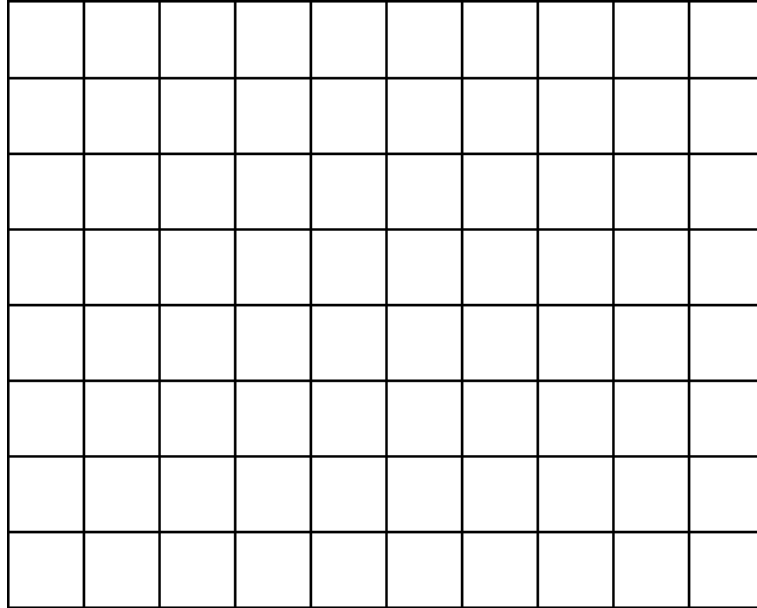
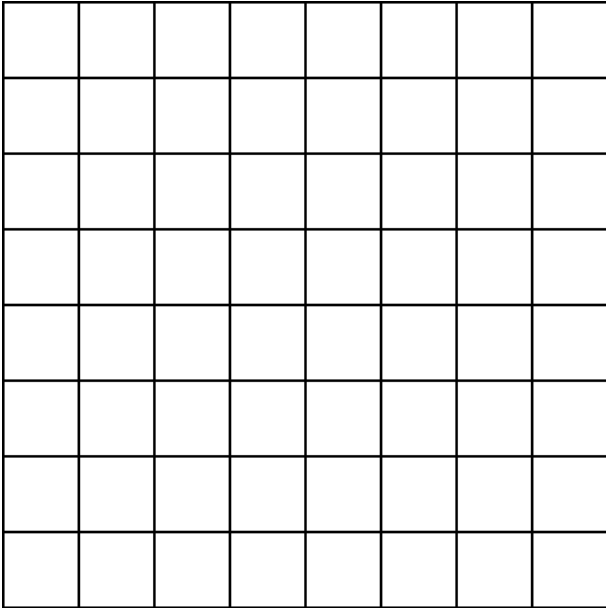
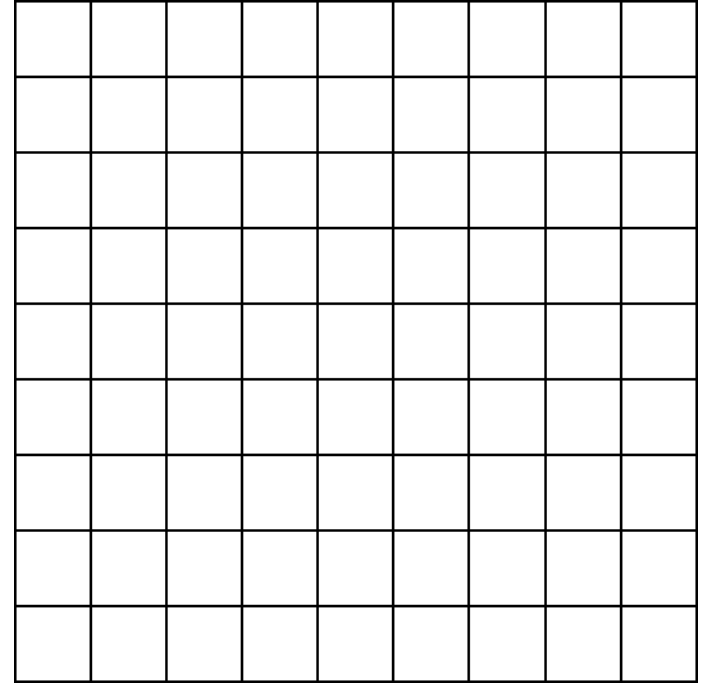
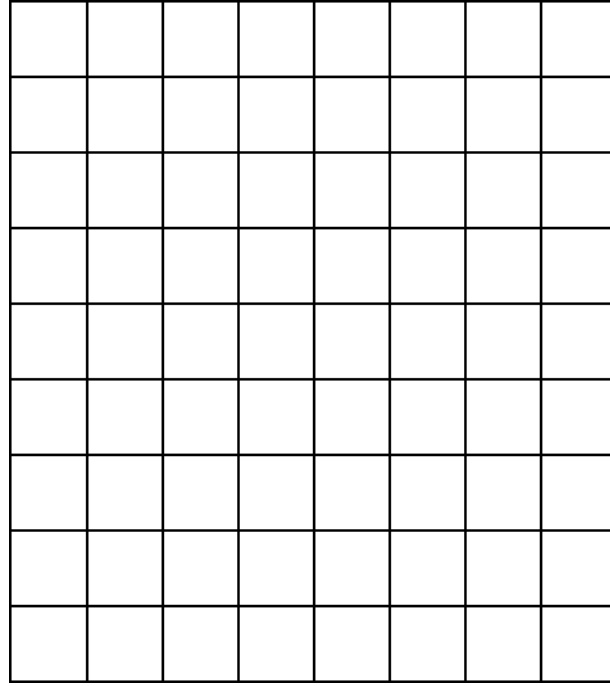
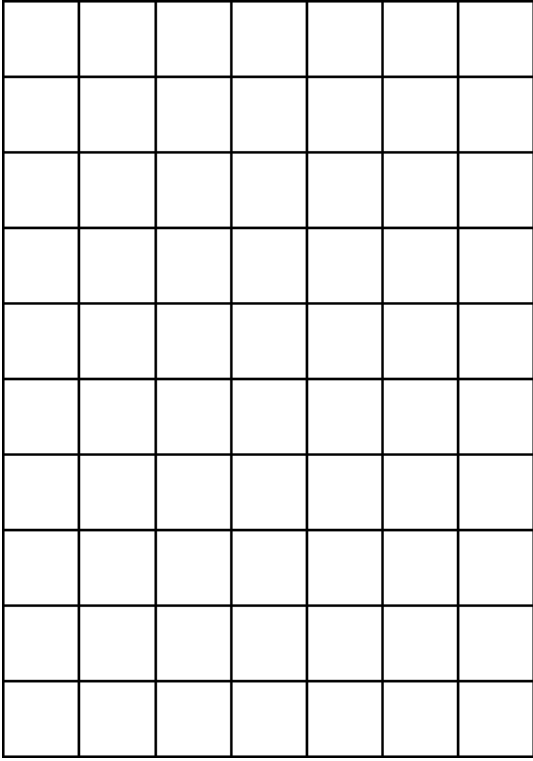

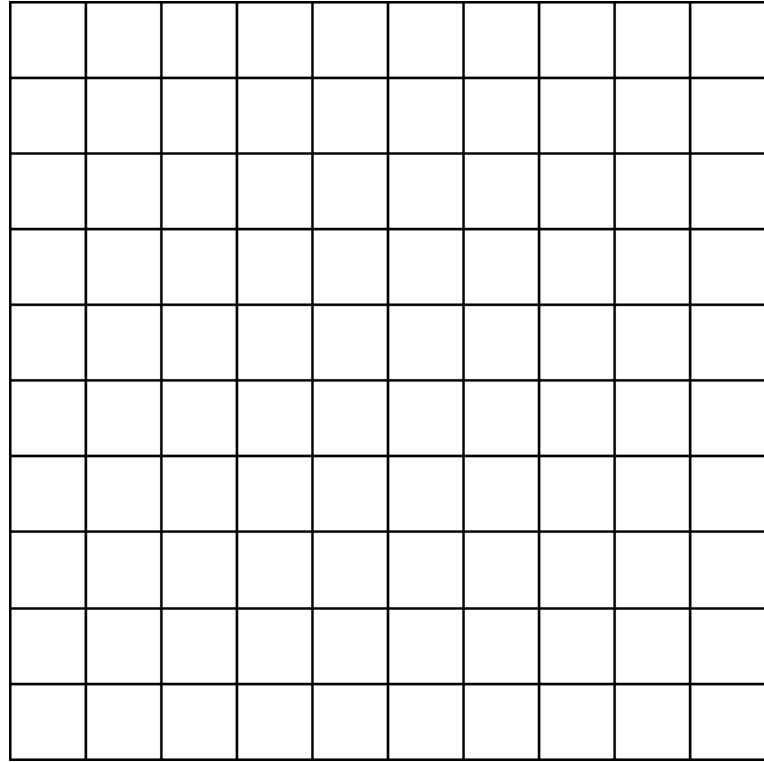
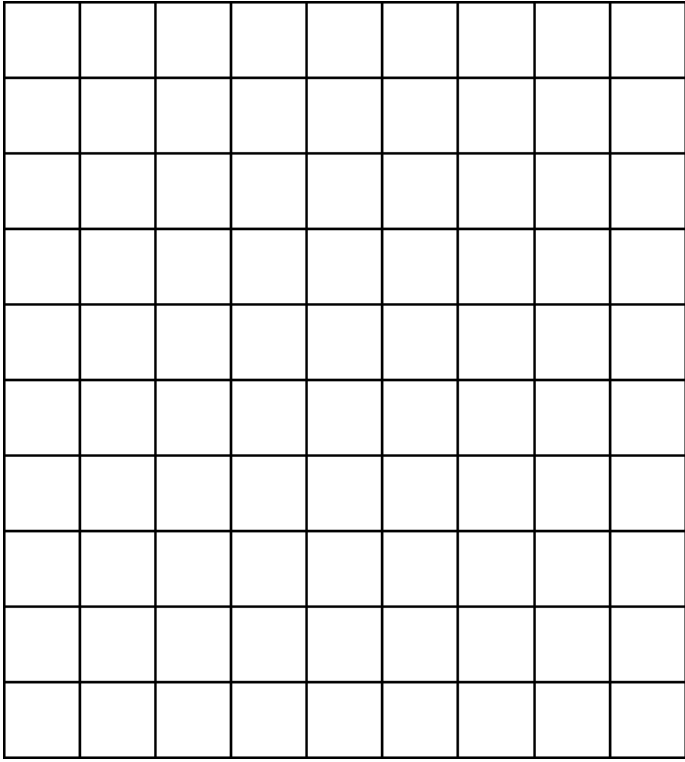
- 1) Deal out all of the array cards, totals face down.
