


Circle Subtraction

Circle Subtraction

Materials:

- 2 different colored pencils or dry erase markers
- Hundreds chart (may be laminated or put into a sheet protector)
- Paper and pencils to show work

Directions:

- 1) Player I circles any number on the hundreds chart.
- 2) Player 2 circles another number on the hundreds chart. Player 2 then finds the difference between the two circled numbers and circles the difference on the hundreds chart. (Now there are three numbers circled.)
- 3) Player I now chooses two of the circled numbers and finds the difference. He circles the difference on the hundreds chart. (Now there are four circled numbers.)
- 4) Play continues with players taking turns circling the number that is the difference between any of the previously circled numbers. Play continues until there are no more numbers that can be circled.
